# Please help us collect new and second-hand instruments to support young Cuban musicians

## No shortage of talent – just resources

Cuba is famous for its music. Creative arts are fully integrated into the curriculum, and the country's free music schools nurture the talent of thousands of skilled young musicians each year. While the commitment and teachers are plentiful, musical instruments and resources are often in short supply because of the impact of the ongoing economic blockade of Cuba by the United States.

Play for Cuba is an exciting new project which will help young musicians across the island by shipping a container full of musical instruments to Cuba in April 2019.

## You can support Play for Cuba by

- collecting and donating instruments;
- sponsoring and fundraising to pay for instruments and transport costs;
- becoming a regional coordinator;
- promoting the appeal in your local communities and organisations.

It's surprising how many instruments are gathering dust in attics, garages, and stock rooms. Skilled craftspeople and musicians in Cuba are waiting to repair and breathe new life and tunes into these.

## What to donate

We are appealing for all new and second-hand instruments, plus reeds, strings, bows and drum sticks, and any associated items such as carrying cases or music stands.

We also need donations and fundraising to pay for the transport of instruments from regional collection hubs to the main container and onward shipping to Cuba.

## Play for Cuba

Play for Cuba is organised by the National Education Union (NUT Section), the Cuba Solidarity Campaign and the UK charity, the Music Fund for Cuba. It was launched at the NEU (NUT Section) conference in 2018 and will run until April 2019 when the full shipping container will be waved off from the NEU conference in Liverpool.
